HB 2552 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Increases amount of income tax credit allowed to rural medical providers.

HB 2602 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Adds nursing assistant or nurse to types of providers who are eligible for income tax credit allowed to rural medical providers.

HB 2626 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Adds licensed mental health professionals and certified medical laboratory scientists and medical laboratory technicians to types of providers eligible for tax credit allowed to rural medical care provider.

HB 2723 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Modifies conditions of eligibility for tax credit allowed to rural medical care provider.

#### Work Session

HB 2278

Authorizes pharmacists to administer influenza vaccine to persons six months of age or older.

HB 2286

Requires Oregon Health Authority to maintain process to identify claims eligible for enhanced federal match for services provided to American Indians or Alaska Natives by nontribal providers, secure enhanced federal match from Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and return to tribe portion of enhanced federal match.
