HB 3157 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Health Insurance Mandate Review Advisory Committee to review each proposed legislative measure, legislative concept or amendment that requires health insurer or health care service contractor to reimburse cost of specified procedure or provider, if measure, concept or amendment is posted to legislative committee's agenda, and to produce report on equity and financial effects of each required coverage that is proposed and efficacy of treatment or service proposed.

HB 2542 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Oregon Health Authority to establish accreditation program for substance use disorder treatment programs.

HB 2736

Enacts interstate Occupational Therapy Licensure Compact.

HB 2584

Removes requirement that physician assistant collaboration agreement with employer include physician assistant performance assessment.

HB 2627

Adds two members who are physician assistants or retired physician assistants to membership of Oregon Medical Board.

HB 2486

Allows certain pharmacy technicians to administer vaccines.

HB 2617 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with Newborn Bloodspot Screening Advisory Board, to adopt rules for board to evaluate and recommend adding disease to or removing disease from newborn bloodspot screening panel or taking no action on disease.

HB 2608 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for specified expenses.

HB 2994

Modifies requirements for health insurance coverage of hearing-related items and services.

HB 2445

Authorizes independent behavioral health certification entity that meets specified requirements to certify addiction peer support specialists to work with coordinated care organizations.
