Public Hearing

HB 2541

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study current and future need for secure residential treatment facility beds and report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health, by September 15, 2023, findings of study and plan for statewide coordination of admissions to, discharges from and waiting lists for facilities and for achieving needed capacity.

HB 2544 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for costs related to increasing statewide capacity of licensed residential facilities serving individuals with substance use disorders or mental health concerns.

HB 3425

Directs Oregon State Board of Nursing to issue license to practice as certified registered nurse anesthetist to qualified applicant.

HB 2757 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Expands and provides funding for coordinated crisis services system including 9-8-8 suicide prevention and behavioral health crisis hotline.

HB 2279

Repeals residency requirement in Oregon Death with Dignity Act.

HB 2446

Requires extension to no later than December 31, 2026, of term for contract between Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organization.

HB 2918 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Health Authority to use to continue pilot program providing grants to entities to operate mobile health units.

HB 2925

Extends deadlines for affinity group task forces to complete their work with respect to allocations of resources to address communities' needs and health inequities faced by communities and to report recommendations to Legislative Assembly.

HB 3040

Requires coordinated care organizations to share claims and encounter data with provider regarding patients that provider contracts with coordinated care organization to serve.

HB 2743 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for Oregon Medical Coordination Center.

HB 2048

Directs Health Licensing Office to issue provisional registration to applicant for behavior analysis interventionist registration.

HB 2574 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires hospitals to adopt policies and procedures to ensure provision of human immunodeficiency virus post-exposure prophylactic drugs or therapies following patient's possible exposure to human immunodeficiency virus.

HB 2773 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide incentives to increase recruitment and retention of local public health professionals.
