Work Session

HB 2445

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/27/2023 MEETING: Authorizes independent behavioral health certification entity that meets specified requirements to certify addiction peer support specialists to work with coordinated care organizations.

HB 2455

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/27/2023 MEETING: Imposes requirements and restrictions on insurer and coordinated care organization audits of claims for reimbursement submitted by behavioral health treatment providers.

HB 2538 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/27/2023 MEETING: Requires health insurance coverage of health care interpretation services that are legally mandated.

HB 2539 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/27/2023 MEETING: Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Trillium Family Services for construction of facility for Oregon Center for Child, Family and Community Health.

HB 3126 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/27/2023 MEETING: Establishes Emergency Behavioral Health Services for Children program in Oregon Health Authority to promote timely delivery of behavioral health services to children who present to hospital emergency departments in behavioral health crises.

HB 2723 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/27/2023 MEETING: Modifies conditions of eligibility for tax credit allowed to rural medical care provider.

HB 2697

Requires hospitals to establish technical staff and service staffing committees to develop staffing plans, in addition to nurse staffing committee.

HB 2742

Excludes certain costs from consideration as total health expenditures for purposes of Health Care Cost Growth Target program.

Public Hearing

HB 2045

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study access to health care in Oregon.

HB 2513

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study implementation of Ballot Measure 110 (2021).
