HB 3324 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/27/2023 MEETING: Directs Oregon Health Authority to establish program to provide incentives to nurse instructors.

Possible Reconsideration and Work Session

HB 2463

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/27/2023 MEETING: Requires Oregon Health Authority to convene two work groups to study statutory and regulatory framework for behavioral health systems and make recommendations to reduce administrative burdens on behavioral health care providers and increase system efficiencies.

HB 2817

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/27/2023 MEETING: Clarifies area of leg to which definition of "podiatry" applies.

HB 2485 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Portland State University, subject to sufficient moneys being appropriated, to enhance state's capacity to educate public mental health and addiction treatment providers by July 1, 2028, by materially increasing number of graduates from relevant degree programs.

HB 3274 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Southern Oregon University, subject to appropriation of sufficient moneys, to address state's behavioral and mental health needs by materially increasing number of mental health practitioners who graduate in southern Oregon and teaching behavioral and mental health competencies through alternative academic pathways.

HB 2397

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study opioid overdose prevention.

HB 3300

Authorizes Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists to issue limited permit to qualified applicant.

HB 2538 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Requires health insurance coverage of health care interpretation services that are legally mandated.

HB 2539 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Trillium Family Services for construction of facility for Oregon Center for Child, Family and Community Health.

HB 3126 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Establishes Emergency Behavioral Health Services for Children program in Oregon Health Authority to promote timely delivery of behavioral health services to children who present to hospital emergency departments in behavioral health crises.
