Possible Reconsideration and Work Session

HB 2235

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study access to behavioral health treatment in rural and medically underserved areas of this state.

Work Session

HB 3380

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Allows physician to prescribe continuous glucose monitor to certain patients whether or not physician specializes in endocrinology. HB 3258

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Requires monitoring and reporting by prescription drug program prescription and dispensation of prescription drugs classified in schedule V of federal Controlled Substances Act.

HB 2513

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Requires Oregon Health Authority to study implementation of Ballot Measure 110 (2021).

HB 2045

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Requires Oregon Health Authority to study access to health care in Oregon.

HB 2697

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Requires hospitals to establish technical staff and service staff staffing committees to develop staffing plans, in addition to nurse staffing committee.

HB 2742

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Excludes certain costs from consideration as total health expenditures for purposes of Health Care Cost Growth Target program.

HB 3596

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Allows person to practice surgical technology at health care facility if person has completed and is certified by specified apprenticeship program.

HB 3320

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Imposes new requirements on hospitals with respect to financial assistance policies and processes.

HB 2878 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Establishes Aligning for Health Pilot Program, administered by Oregon Health Authority, to test alternative methods for payment for health care.

HB 2445

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Authorizes independent behavioral health certification entity that meets specified requirements to certify addiction peer support specialists to work with coordinated care organizations.

HB 2455

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2023 MEETING: Imposes requirements and restrictions on insurer and coordinated care organization audits of claims for reimbursement submitted by behavioral health treatment providers.

Note change: Possible Reconsideration and Work Session on HB 2235 added. HB 3380, HB 3258, HB 2513, HB 2045, HB 2697, HB 2742, HB 3596, HB 3320, HB 2878, HB 2445, and HB 2455 carried over.
