#### Public Hearing

SB 226

Removes requirement that Oregon State Board of Nursing notify State Board of Pharmacy upon authorizing nurse practitioner or clinical nurse specialist to dispense prescription drugs.

SB 227

During emergency declared by Governor, allows Oregon State Board of Nursing to issue limited license to practice nursing to nurse licensed in another jurisdiction and to issue limited certificate as nursing assistant to nursing assistant authorized to practice in another jurisdiction.

SB 969

Removes requirement that Oregon State Board of Nursing certify as nursing assistant any qualified applicant.

SB 703

Requires passage of specified examination for certification as nursing assistant.

#### Work Session

SB 463

Prohibits health benefit plans from imposing prior authorization or other utilization review requirements on coverage of proton beam therapy that do not apply to coverage of radiation therapy.

SB 628 A

Requires health benefit plan and health care service contract coverage of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome.

SB 797 A

Requires coverage under health insurance policy for prosthetic and orthotic devices.

SB 189 A

Allows health care facility to transfer human pathological waste, which includes biopsy materials, human tissues and anatomical parts that emanate from surgeries, autopsies and

obstetrical and laboratory procedures on humans, to donor of pathological waste or authorized representative of donor if waste is intended for cremation, interment or other final disposition.

SB 558 A

Exempts from regulation by Advisory Council on Hearing Aids and Health Licensing Office over-the-counter hearing aid.
