Work Session

SB 232

Allows out-of-state physician or physician assistant to provide specified care to patients located in Oregon.

SB 376 A

Provides authority to Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to require health care service contractors to file annual National Association of Insurance Commissioners own risk and solvency assessment summary reports and corporate governance annual disclosure reports.

SB 450

Exempts from labeling requirements drug intended to reverse opioid overdose when drug is dispensed by physician or physician assistant.

SB 965 A

Allows Oregon Health Authority to conduct off-site investigation after receiving certain complaints against hospitals.

SB 1043 A

Requires hospitals and other specified facilities that provide substance use disorder treatment to provide to specified patients upon discharge or release two doses of opioid overdose reversal medication and necessary medical supplies to administer medication.

SB 217 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/8/2023 MEETING: Requires that cosmetology curriculum taught by school meet standards established by Board of Cosmetology and be approved by Health Licensing Office.
