Public Hearing

HB 2449

Prohibits insurer from canceling or raising premiums on policies of fire insurance by more than three percent if insured's property is located within wildland-urban interface or insured's primary employment or economic or business activity is farming or resource extraction.

HB 2870

Permits contractors to submit bonds in lieu of retainage for construction projects and public improvement contracts.

HB 3183

Requires Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to require applicant for cannabis-related license or license renewal to submit signed attestation that applicant will refrain from interfering with labor organizing efforts or submit attestation that applicant and labor organization that is certified to represent employees of applicant have entered into and will abide by terms of labor peace agreement.

HB 3227

Makes changes to Custodians' Civil Service Law to remove barriers to filling employment vacancies and remove certain qualifications for members of civil service board.

HB 3213
