#### Work Session

HB 2620

Punishes violation of laws that regulate home solicitation sales as unlawful practice under Unlawful Trade Practices Act.

HB 2759

Provides that person that knows or consciously avoids knowing that another person is engaging in act or practice that violates laws that regulate telephone solicitations or use of automatic dialing and announcing devices and nonetheless provides substantial assistance or support for violation is liable for loss and subject to penalty to same extent as person that engaged in violation.

HB 3200

Repeals provision specifying fiscal year end date for credit unions.

#### Public Hearing

HB 3306

Requires entity that receives funds for certain workforce program initiatives to establish wage standards for individuals who participate in program administered by entity if, under program, entity provides individuals with paid work experience.

HB 3307

Provides that individuals who participate in certain on-the-job training programs are entitled to certain rights and protections concerning civil rights, discrimination and harassment as employees in employment relationship with employer.

HB 3412

Authorizes physician assistants to provide compensable medical services and authorize payment of temporary disability benefits under same rules as nurse practitioners for workers' compensation claims.

**March 15, 2023**

HB 3471

Prohibits employer from entering into settlement or agreement disposing of workers' compensation claim that bars worker from seeking further employment with employer unless such provision is first requested by worker.
