### Work Session

HB 3541

Extends exemption of insured employer from liability outside workers' compensation law to employer's parent company and related entities of employer under same parent company. HB 2277

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/29 AGENDA: Removes exemption from regulation by Department of Consumer and Business Services for self-insured plans of insurance operating solely in this state.

### HB 2515

Allows marijuana producer, marijuana wholesaler, marijuana processor or marijuana retailer to use motion detection camera system at licensed premises.

### HB 2556

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/29 AGENDA: Requires that itemized statements provided to employees explain, in plain language, amount and purpose of each deduction.

HB 2870

Permits contractors to submit bonds in lieu of retainage for construction projects and public improvement contracts.

HB 3205

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/29 AGENDA: Modifies definition of "compensation," for purposes of pay equity requirements, to exclude hiring bonuses and retention bonuses.

### HB 3306

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/29 AGENDA: Requires entity that receives funds for certain workforce program initiatives to establish wage standards for individuals who participate in program administered by entity if, under program, entity provides individuals with paid work experience.

#### HB 3385

Requires certain residential general contractors proposing remodel or repair project of more than \$20,000 in value to tour residential structure with property owner and provide property owner with itemized and detailed description for each feature of proposed construction work.
