HB 3056 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Extends Residential Heat Pump Fund until January 2, 2026.

HB 3166 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires State Department of Energy, in consultation with Housing and Community Services Department, to establish whole-home energy savings program and high-efficiency electric home rebate program.

HB 2534
Requires State Department of Energy to work with stakeholders to identify areas of inquiry regarding energy and energy use in this state, develop research options and convene advisory group to develop recommendations and benchmarks around energy and energy use in this state.

HB 3273
Repeals Department of Environmental Quality's dry cleaner environmental program.

HB 2530
Directs State Department of Energy to convene work group to examine, evaluate and develop statewide strategies to accelerate development of state renewable hydrogen industry.

Public Hearing

HB 3220
Modifies provisions of electronics recycling program.

HB 3004
Requires State Department of Energy to study renewable energy resource development.
