HB 3595

Establishes factors to be considered when Superintendent of Public Instruction enters into contract with education service district or school district to provide educational services to youths in Youth Corrections Education Program or Juvenile Detention Education Program.

HB 2767

Establishes requirements for approving recovery schools.

SB 279 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Enacts Interstate Teacher Mobility Compact.

HB 2281

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Requires school districts and public charter schools to designate civil rights coordinator.

HB 2739

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to prepare tentative budget for funding of State School Fund.

HB 2753

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Allows district school board to choose to provide directors with monthly stipend.

HB 3135

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Preserves additional funding for small school districts that merge with one or more school districts if certain conditions are met.

HB 3178

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Expands criteria for awarding scholarships to diverse teacher candidates.

HB 3204

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Modifies timelines and requirements for when school district makes determination whether to give approval for student to enroll in virtual public charter school not sponsored by school district.

HB 3288

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Directs State Board of Education to adopt uniform standards related to collection of specified data.

HB 3584

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Directs schools or school districts to provide electronic communication to parents and guardians of students attending, and to school district employees employed at, school at which safety threat action occurred.

HB 3236 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/20/2023 AGENDA: Authorizes expenditures from Statewide

Education Initiatives Account for funding of regional career and technical education programs.

HB 2656 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires each school district to ensure students of school district participate in specified surveys used to determine if schools provide environment for healthy and successful learners.

HB 2690

Requires school district to pay classified school employee not less than 10 percent more than minimum wage that applies to all employees who work in this state and not less than 15 percent more than minimum wage if classified school employee provides support to students with individualized education program or who are enrolled in special education.

HB 3030 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Universal School Meal Account for purpose of reimbursing school districts for
certain costs incurred in providing federally reimbursable meals.

HB 3031

Requires Department of Education to study matters related to ventilation and energy efficiency in schools.

HB 3068

Provides that high school student in grade 11 or 12 may be awarded high school diploma if student has received certificate for passing approved high school equivalency test such as General Educational Development (GED) test and meets other conditions.

HB 3584

Directs schools or school districts to provide electronic communication to parents and guardians of students attending, and to school district employees employed at, school at which safety threat action occurred.

HB 3199

Requires Department of Education to convene advisory group to review physical education requirements for certain students in grades six through eight.

Note change: SB 279 A, HB 2281, HB 2739, HB 2753, HB 3135, HB 3178, HB 3204, HB 3288, HB 3584, and HB 3236 were added.
