SB 279 A

HB 3595

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/29/2023 AGENDA: Establishes factors to be considered when Superintendent of Public Instruction enters into contract with education service district or school district to provide educational services to youths in Youth Corrections Education Program or Juvenile Detention Education Program.

HB 2264

Requires Department of Education to conduct study to determine how best to ensure all high school graduates are academically prepared to attend post-secondary institutions of education.

HB 3198 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes Early Literacy Success Initiative.

HB 3454 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs Department of Education to award grants to improve early literacy in state.

Requires school districts to file with Superintendent of Public Instruction information about allocations and expenditures of moneys received from State School Fund.
