Public Hearing

- HB 2271 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Makes Veteran Educational Bridge Grant Program permanent.
- HB 2840
Provides for additional forms of identification that may be used by person to prove status as veteran when applying for veterans' recognition registration plate.
- HB 2898
Extends time during which recreational vehicle may be sited on lot with single-family dwelling that was damaged by natural disaster.

Work Session

- HB 2812 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Creates Oregon tax subtraction for amounts of personal casualty loss that are barred from deduction on federal tax return because loss is not attributable to federally declared disaster.
- HB 3000 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Transportation to cover costs associated with Fallen Hero roadside memorial signs and veterans' recognition registration plates for biennium beginning July 1, 2023.
- HB 3001 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Transportation to waive fee for Fallen Hero roadside memorial highway sign if applicant is Gold Star Family member and funds are appropriated or otherwise made available to department for purpose of paying fees.
