Public Hearing

HB 2904

Requires institution or research facility that performs research, testing or studies involving nonhuman primates to annually report certain information to State Veterinarian.

HB 3127

Prohibits installation or download of certain covered products onto state information technology assets.

HB 2490

Exempts from required disclosure records concerning cybersecurity plans, devices and systems, including contractual and insurance records setting forth specifications, applications and coverages.
