Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3564

Increases number of members of Higher Education Coordinating Commission representing congressional districts from five to six and decreases number of members of commission representing general public from four to three.

HB 3565

Establishes Oregon Tribal Student Grant program.

HB 3120

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine best method for connecting public higher education to workforce and economic development needs of Oregon.

HB 2204 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Creates income or corporate excise tax credit for taxpayer that employs youth through Oregon Youth Employment Program.

HB 2262

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine how best to fund public pre-kindergarten through post-secondary education in Oregon.

HB 3121

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine best method for making public higher education affordable for Oregonians.

HB 3560

Prohibits person from suing Higher Education Coordinating Commission for commission's performance, or failure to perform, any duty, function or power relating to psilocybin products following effective date of Ballot Measure 109 (2020).

HB 3561

Specifies that term "early childhood care and education" includes early childhood behavioral and mental health services for purposes of scholarships and grants awarded to ensure state has adequate supply of early childhood care and education professionals.
