**Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2023 AGENDA: Creates income or corporate excise tax credit for taxpayer that employs youth through Oregon Youth Employment Program.

HB 3121

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2023 AGENDA: Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine best method for making public higher education affordable for Oregonians.

HB 3561

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2023 AGENDA: Specifies that term "early childhood care and education" includes early childhood behavioral and mental health services for purposes of scholarships and grants awarded to ensure state has adequate supply of early childhood care and education professionals.

HB 3563

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2023 AGENDA: Creates Oregon Youth Works Advisory Board to advise on and oversee implementation and alignment of youth workforce development programs for which Higher Education Coordinating Commission is responsible.

HB 3564

HB 3120

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine how best to coordinate post-secondary education in Oregon.

HB 2265

HB 3452
