HB 3092
Creates residential property wholesaler registration.

HB 2981 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Oregon Business Development Department to provide grants and loans for housing.

Please note: The following bill is scheduled solely for the purpose of moving the bill to the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care.

HB 3415
Requires Oregon State Board of Nursing to study nursing workforce.

Public Hearing

HB 3174 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to provide grants to local governments for regional housing coordinators.

HB 2260
Requires Housing and Community Services Department to study system development charges impacting housing.

HB 3268
Establishes Rural System Development Charges Program within Housing and Community Services Department to pay system development charges for rural affordable multifamily housing.

Note change: a public hearing for HB 3268 has been added. A work session on HB 3415 has been added for the sole purpose of moving the bill to the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care. Work sessions have been moved to the beginning of the committee meeting.
