HB 2653 **

Creates credit against income taxes for selling publicly supported housing to retain as affordable

HB 3042

Limits terminations and rent increases for three years after tenants' housing is withdrawn from publicly supported housing.

HB 2634

Defines "recreational vehicle park" for the purposes of residential tenancy law.

Requires Department of Land Conservation and Development to study housing.
