Work Session

HB 2320

Establishes Juvenile Justice Advisory Commission within Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.

HB 3036 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Permits education provider to operate video recording device for purpose of recording persons who fail to stop for bus safety lights.

HB 3443

Prohibits landlords from terminating lease or taking other specified actions due to status of tenant as victim of bias crime.

Public Hearing

HB 3392

Allows removing authority to publish notice of intent to dispose of unclaimed property via publicly viewable electronic method as alternative to newspaper.

HB 3581 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes State Treasurer to issue Article XI-Q general obligation bonds to finance expansion of courthouses.

SB 317

Provides that requirement that certain hearsay statements of unavailable witnesses concerning acts of abuse must be supported by corroborative evidence applies in juvenile delinquency proceedings.

SB 529

Modifies legislative findings concerning alternative incarceration programs.
