Public Hearing

SB 339 A

Authorizes court to require as condition of probation for person convicted of harassment completion of sex offender treatment program and submission to polygraph examinations, if recommended by probation officer and if harassment involved touching of sexual or intimate parts of another person.

SB 568 A

Provides that court is not required to hold hearing on petition to vacate defendant's requirement to install and use ignition interlock device while participating in diversion program.

SB 586

Makes restorative justice communications confidential.

SB 867

Provides that witness is unavailable for purposes of hearsay rules if witness is absent from hearing and proponent of statement has established that party against whom statement is offered engaged in certain conduct that caused witness to be unavailable.

Work Session

SB 581 A

Modifies applicability of earned reduction of supervision changes in House Bill 2172 (2021).

SB 864

Provides that person who voluntarily fights wildfire on private forestland is not civilly liable for injury to person or property resulting from good faith performance of firefighting efforts.
