SB 305

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-19-2023 MEETING: Modifies provisions relating to special motions to strike.

SB 306 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-19-2023 MEETING: Modifies statutes to allow for nonattorney associate members of the Oregon State Bar to practice law in certain scope of practice.

SB 586

Makes restorative justice communications confidential.

#### **Public Hearing**

SB 212 A

Makes confidential and exempts from discovery and public records certain communications and information conveyed during, to facilitate or to follow up on peer support check-in sessions with Oregon Youth Authority employees.

SB 902

Permits person who is 20 years of age or older at time of resentencing for crime committed when person was under 18 years of age to continue temporary assignment to youth correction facility if person was temporarily assigned to youth correction facility following original sentence.

SB 903

Directs Oregon Youth Authority to maintain certain demographic data.

SB 904 A

Modifies criteria for determining maximum allowable population levels for youth correction facilities.
