Work Session

SB 310

Increases amount of civil penalty Attorney General may obtain for violation of antitrust statutes from \$250,000 to \$1 million.

SB 311

Modifies damages and penalties awarded for action for false claims.

SB 317

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-24-2023 MEETING: Provides that requirement that certain hearsay statements of unavailable witnesses concerning acts of abuse must be supported by corroborative evidence applies in juvenile delinquency proceedings.

SB 529

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-24-2023 MEETING: Modifies legislative findings concerning alternative incarceration programs.

SB 597

Directs certifying agencies to report annually to Oregon Criminal Justice Commission on victim helpfulness certification requests.

SB 810

Reconciles and modifies penalties for certain offenses involving unmanned aircraft systems.

Public Hearing

SB 787

Expands crime of assault in the third degree to include assault of public transit vehicle operator acting in course of official duty.

SB 862 A

Permits owner of self-service storage facility to advertise or publish notice of sale of personal property that is subject to lien once in newspaper of general circulation or on publicly accessible website that regularly advertises or offers personal property for auction or sale.
