SB 212 A

Makes confidential and exempts from discovery and public records certain communications and information conveyed during, to facilitate or to follow up on peer support check-in sessions with Oregon Youth Authority employees.

SB339 A

> CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-9-2023 MEETING: Authorizes court to require as condition of probation for person convicted of harassment completion of sex offender treatment program and submission to polygraph examinations, if recommended by probation officer and if harassment involved touching of sexual or intimate parts of another person.

Modifies when venue is proper for property offenses committed against same victim within 180 days.

SB 615 A

Modifies crime of organizing speed racing event.

SB618 A

> CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-9-2023 MEETING: Directs court to consider, when determining aggravation at sentencing, whether defendant was wearing body armor at time of crime.

808 A

Modifies certain provisions relating to Commission on Statewide Law Enforcement Standards of Conduct and Discipline.

957 A

Expands types of prior convictions that increase offense level for crime of public indecency.

Creates crime of sexual abuse by fraudulent representation.
