#### Work Session

SB 343 A

Clarifies that "incarceration" means confinement in Department of Corrections institution for purposes of certain driving privilege revocations and suspensions.

SB 519 A

Modifies procedure for expunction of certain juvenile records.

SB 614 A

Permits law enforcement agency to collect and maintain information about person's political, religious or social views or activities if information was collected and maintained for lawful purpose, including activities carried out in accordance with policy for officer-worn video cameras.

SB 895

Modifies offense of passing in no passing zone.

#### Public Hearing

SB 745 A

Directs county juvenile department to ensure that specified youth or adjudicated youth receives sex trafficking screening.

SB 780 A

Creates offense of unlawful fender height modifications.

SB 807 A

***Public testimony is limited to those who were registered to testify on Monday, 5/8 but were unable to testify or finish their testimony.***

Provides procedure whereby elected judge may challenge party, attorney, law firm, district attorney's office, defense consortium or public defender's office that files motions to disqualify judge that effectively deny judge assignment to criminal or juvenile delinquency docket.
