SB 699

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-17-2023 MEETING: Expands definition of "public safety officer" to include certain regulatory specialists as persons who may be eligible for benefit awards from Public Safety Memorial Fund.

SB 787

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-17-2023 MEETING: Expands crime of assault in the third degree to include assault of public transit vehicle operator acting in course of official duty.

SB 807 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-17-2023 MEETING: Provides procedure whereby elected judge may challenge party, attorney, law firm, district attorney's office, defense consortium or public defender's office that files motions to disqualify judge that effectively deny judge assignment to criminal or juvenile delinquency docket.

SB 951

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-17-2023 MEETING: Provides that certified parole and probation officer employed by State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision qualifies as police officer under Public Employees Retirement System.
