Work Session

HB 2086

Allows correction of maximum assessed value due to new property or new improvements to property erroneously added to tax roll for current tax year and up to five preceding tax years.

Public Hearing

HB 2596

Creates subtraction from federal taxable income for amounts received as grants related to preventing wildfire.

HB 3446

Provides for homestead rebuilt by same owner on same lot to replace homestead destroyed by September 2020 wildfires to have frozen assessed value equal to assessed value for 2020-2021 property tax year to extent of destroyed homestead's square footage.

HB 3461

Authorizes temporary deferral of property taxes on homesteads rebuilt after 2020 wildfires in amount by which taxes exceed 103 percent of property taxes on destroyed homestead for 2020-2021 property tax year.
