HB 3551

Increases maximum weight cutoff for eligibility of aircraft for 60 percent valuation for purposes of property taxation of mobile property of air transportation companies.

Work Session

HB 2976 A**

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Oregon Spirits Board as semi-independent state agency to develop and promote Oregon's distilled spirits industry.

HB 3014 A**

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs State Board of Education to adopt rules that allow for reimbursement of school district expenses incurred for alternative transportation costs.

HB 3221 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases amounts of moneys that are not considered Local Revenues for purposes of State School Fund distributions to school districts.

HB 2073

Requires Legislative Revenue Officer to study corporate activity tax.
