HB 3625

Withdraws all applications for amendment convention under Article V of United States Constitution that were previously made by Legislative Assembly and declares these applications null and void.

HJM 3

Informs Congress that all applications for amendment convention under Article V of United States Constitution made by Legislative Assembly before effective date of chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 3625), are withdrawn and are null and void.

Work Session

HB 2725

Prohibits pharmacy benefit manager from imposing fees on rural pharmacies after point of sale. HB 3013 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires pharmacy benefit managers to be licensed by Department of Consumer and Business Services beginning January 1, 2024, and imposes new requirements on pharmacy benefit managers.

HB 2038

Requires statement of economic interest to include certain information about sources of income for business in which public official or candidate, or member of household of public official or candidate, is officer, holds directorship or does business under if source of income has legislative or administrative interest and 10 percent or more of total gross annual income of business comes from that source of income.

HB 3073

Prohibits Secretary of State and county clerks from disclosing as public record, or including on lists of electors, residence address of elector who is candidate for elected office or holder of elected office.
