HB 3632

Increases statute of limitations for first degree sex crimes to 20 years after commission of crime or, for minor victim, any time before victim attains 30 years of age, whichever occurs later.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 70 A

Modifies requirements for residential rezoning of lands within Eastern Oregon Border Economic Development Region.

SJR 34 A

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to establish Independent Public Service Compensation Commission.

SB 28 A

Prescribes method for creating ballot title and explanatory statement for Senate Joint Resolution 34, if resolution is referred to people.

Work Session

HB 2765

Grants to South Suburban Sanitary District exclusive right to use and sell treated wastewater discharged by district into Klamath River or tributaries.

HB 3216

Directs Department of Corrections to determine last-known address of adults in custody, if address is readily known or available to adult in custody, and submit information to Secretary of State.
