SB 633 \*\* \*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes program to provide high-quality services and improved outcomes through regional centers for special education and related services.
SB 595 \*\* \*Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue
Requires Department of Education to transfer from State School Fund to Talented and Gifted Education Account amount that equals one percent of total amount available to school districts as general purpose grants.

#### SB 238

SB

Directs Oregon Health Authority, State Board of Education and Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission to collaborate on developing curricula supplements related to dangers of certain drugs and to laws that provide immunity or other protections related to drug or alcohol use. 940

Requires Department of Education to conduct study to identify improved processes for transferring high school credits earned by student outside United States.
