Work Session

- SB 633 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2023 AGENDA: Establishes program to provide high-quality services and improved outcomes through regional centers for special education and related services.
- SB 595 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2023 AGENDA: Requires Department of Education to transfer from State School Fund to Talented and Gifted Education Account amount that equals one percent of total amount available to school districts as general purpose grants.
- SB 596 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2023 AGENDA: Requires school districts to submit specified information to Department of Education related to talented and gifted children.
- SB 736
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2023 AGENDA: Requires Department of Education to conduct study to identify how to increase access to advanced instruction for purpose of preparing students for college and career.
- SB 756
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2023 AGENDA: Requires school district employees assigned to work with students with specialized needs to have access to specified records related to students and to be consulted when education plan for student is reviewed or revised.
- SB 416
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/23/2023 MEETING: Requires public universities and community colleges to pay part-time faculty at same rate, on per-hour basis, as public university or community college pays full-time faculty to prepare for and teach course.
- SB 768
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/23/2023 MEETING: Requires Department of Education to conduct study to determine feasibility of collecting student course grade history in grades 6 through 12.

- SB 275
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/23/2023 MEETING: Requires Department of Education, Teacher Standards and Practices Commission and Educator Advancement Council to conduct study to identify best means of improving alignment among state education agencies.
- SB 1045
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/23/2023 MEETING: Directs Department of Education to review department's statutes, rules and internal policies to identify how best to incorporate suggestions made by Secretary of State following audit of education in this state.
- SB 1002
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/23/2023 MEETING: Eliminates State School Fund distributions for facility grants.
- SB 421 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes youth advisory council.
- SB 273
Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine how to best coordinate post-secondary education in Oregon.
- SB 3
Requires students to complete one credit of future planning as requirement for high school diploma.
- SB 854
Requires each school district board to develop written plan establishing climate change instructional program for kindergarten through grade 12 no later than June 1, 2026.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 278
Requires separate calculation of virtual public charter school ADMw if school district that sponsors virtual public charter school had decrease in ADMw as compared to previous school year.
- SB 409
Prescribes information related to courses of study offered by school district that district school board must ensure is provided on school district's website.
- SB 1050
Aligns implementation date of academic content standards for Holocaust and genocide studies with implementation date of academic content standards for ethnic studies.
- SB 1066 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on For-Profit Providers of Educational Services in Virtual Public Charter Schools.
- SB 885 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Library for biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for purpose of hiring consultant to assist libraries apply for federal moneys for purpose of providing broadband access.
- SB 1075 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Education to establish school media program standards and provide technical assistance related to those standards.
- SB 262
Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine best method for decreasing student debt held by students who attend public post-secondary institutions of education.
