#### Public Hearing

HB 3584

Directs schools or school districts to provide electronic communication to parents and guardians of students attending, and to school district employees employed at, school at which safety threat action occurred.

HB 2618 A

Requires Department of Education to conduct study to identify best methodology for determining appropriate number of students on workload for certain school-based health practitioners.

HB 2669

Declares children who are deaf, hard of hearing or deaf-blind have same rights and potential as children who are not deaf, hard of hearing or deaf-blind.

HB 2753 A

Allows district school board to choose to provide directors with monthly stipend and individual directors to decline to receive stipend.
