SB 54 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Removes provisions of property tax exemption for community solar projects that restrict exemption to proportion owned by residential customers or leased by residential subscribers.

SB 124 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes grant program within State Department of Energy to provide grants to fund replacement of generators that use diesel or fossil fuels with renewable hydrogen-fueled generators.

SB 125 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Transportation to establish grant program for fuel cell electric vehicle and hydrogen fueling demonstration projects.
