#### **Work Session**

SB :

Directs Department of Revenue to develop schedule allowing personal income taxpayers to voluntarily report taxpayers' self-identified race and ethnicity identifiers.

SB 158 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Extends sunsets for pass-through business alternative income tax and related personal income tax credit.

SB 205

Allows Department of Revenue to disclose to and give access to Employment Department employees, for purpose of detecting whether identity theft or fraud has been committed, otherwise confidential taxpayer information.

## **Public Hearing**

SB 225 A

Provides that unused portion of amount of pass-through revenue bonds authorized for issuance in preceding biennium carries forward until legislation authorizing amount of pass-through revenue bonds for current biennium is enacted.
