SB 303

Directs Oregon Health Authority to require psilocybin service centers and psilocybin service facilitators licensed by authority to collect and report specified data.

SB 404

Requires State Board of Pharmacy to study prescription drugs.

SB 497

Requires state medical assistance program and health insurance policies and certificates to cover computerized tomography coronary calcium score scans.

SB 628

Requires health benefit plan and health care service contract coverage of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome.

SB 797

Requires coverage under health insurance policy for prosthetic and orthotic devices.

SB 824

Prohibits person from advertising or representing to resident of this state through words, symbols or other oral or written communications in any medium that person operates as treatment center or provides or offers to provide treatment service in return for valuable consideration unless person has license, registration, certification or other authorization from Oregon Health Authority that authorizes person to operate as treatment center or provide particular treatment service and under which person must adhere to specified standard of care.
