**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-22-2023 MEETING: Requires Oregon Health Authority to develop, implement and administer program to support consumer engagement efforts aimed at increasing and optimizing consumer involvement in planning and decision-making surrounding the access to, and the delivery of, behavioral health services in this state.

SB 607

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study membership of Pain Management Commission.

SB 1044

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study access to behavioral health treatment.

SB 1046

Expands network adequacy requirements to health benefit plans offered to large employers and modifies requirements.

SB 490 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

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Directs Oregon Medical Board to support alliance program for family medicine residency training programs in this state.

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-22-2023 MEETING: Requires licensed hospitals to include in hospital's discharge policy specified procedures for discharge of homeless patients.

SB 608

Prohibits insurers offering policies or certificates of health insurance and pharmacy benefit managers from requiring claim for reimbursement of prescription drug to include modifier or other indicator that drug is 340B drug.

SB 408 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Oregon Health Authority to establish process to receive and review health care profession scope of practice requests and impact statements.

SB 492

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-22-2023 MEETING: Imposes new requirements on the determination of health services to be provided in state medical assistance program.
