  - \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Requires providers of substance use treatment or detoxification services, hospitals, long term care facilities, residential care facilities and providers of outpatient physical or behavioral health services, upon release, discharge or transfer of patient or resident or at conclusion of patient visit, to provide two doses of overdose reversal medication and medical supplies necessary to administer medication if patient or resident has prescription for opioid medication or has history of opioid use.
- SB 1076

Requires licensed hospitals to include in hospital's discharge policy specified procedures for discharge of homeless patients.
