#### Work Session

HB 2127 A

Removes deadline by which City of Pendleton must apply to Land Conservation and Development Commission to become part of affordable housing pilot program.

HB 2889 A

Amends Oregon Housing Needs Analysis and land use requirements for local governments related to urbanization.

HB 3417 A

Expands landlord guarantee program to include landlords providing housing to tenants who have received rental assistance under specified rehousing initiative.

HB 3462 A

Provides that, if certain state agencies provide temporary housing to displaced individuals in response to emergency, agencies shall ensure housing is safe and provided in compliance with state and federal laws relating to discrimination.
