SB 573

Directs Center for Health Statistics to enter name of parent on original record of live birth when paternity or parentage has been determined under certain circumstances.

SB 420 **

Directs Department of Human Services to provide specified services to individuals with brain injuries and to convene Brain Injury Advisory Committee.

SB 201

Removes requirement that each community developmental disabilities program and support service brokerage have written management plan.
