Public Hearing

- SB 202 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Human Services to develop and administer voluntary placement program to provide supports to certain young adults as they transition to adulthood.
- SB 208
Grants juvenile court continuing wardship jurisdiction upon establishment of permanent guardianship, regardless of whether original bases for wardship jurisdiction continue to exist.
- SB 209
Requires Department of Human Services to study options for protecting from disclosure in certain proceedings information regarding sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression of children in department's custody.
- SB 231 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Human Services to establish and maintain centralized child abuse reporting system.
