Public Hearing

- SB 524 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to convene advisory council to consider policy implications of identifying specific crimes for which conviction is disqualifying conviction for individuals seeking licensure or registration from Teacher Standards and Practices Commission or seeking employment or contract with school district.
- SB 793
Creates rebuttable presumption that protected person consents to ordinary and preventive health care.
- SB 808
Modifies membership and other provisions relating to the Commission on Statewide Law Enforcement Standards of Conduct and Discipline.

Work Session

- SB 586
Makes restorative justice communications confidential.
- SB 745
Directs juvenile department to ensure that youth taken into custody receives sex trafficking screening.
- HB 2329
Modifies execution formalities for appointment of person to make decisions concerning disposition of remains and for declaration for mental health treatment.
