#### **Public Hearing**

SB 344

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study use of technology to improve accuracy when measuring recidivism rates of persons convicted of felonies, and to provide results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2024.

SB 376

Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to study insurance.

SB 780

Creates offense of unlawful fender height modifications.

SB 951

Provides that certified parole and probation officer employed by State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision qualifies as police officer under Public Employees Retirement System.

SB 1061

Directs Oregon Cannabis Commission, Oregon Health Authority, Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission and Department of Revenue to work collaboratively to ensure access to cannabis for Oregonians.

#### **Work Session**

SB 536

Establishes best interest standard for recommendations or sales of annuities to prospective purchasers.

SB 615

Modifies crime of organizing speed racing event.

SB 807

Provides procedure whereby elected judge may challenge attorney, law firm, district attorney's office or public defender's office that files motions to disqualify judge with such frequency as to effectively deny judge assignment to criminal or juvenile delinquency docket.

SB 808

Modifies membership and other provisions relating to the Commission on Statewide Law Enforcement Standards of Conduct and Discipline.

SB 862

Permits owner of self-service storage facility to advertise or publish notice of sale of personal property that is subject to lien once in newspaper of general circulation or on publicly accessible website that regularly advertises or offers personal property for auction or sale.

SB 910

Excludes certain on-street and off-street parking pay stations from requirement to accept coins and currency as payment for goods and services.

SB 955

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to support implementation of AgriStress Helpline in Oregon.
