SB

Creates Deadly Force Prosecutions Unit within Criminal Justice Division of Department of Justice.

SB344

> Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study use of technology to improve accuracy when measuring recidivism rates of persons convicted of felonies, and to provide results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2024.

SB376

Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to study insurance.

SB
