#### Public Hearing

HB 2676 A

Modifies Department of Justice crime victim compensation program.

HB 2405 A

Requires that court dismissing charges involving orders of commitment due to defendant lacking fitness to proceed also order transport of defendant back to jurisdiction in which charges were initiated.

HB 3242 A

Provides insured with cause of action for insurer's unfair claim settlement practices, other than practices related to settling workers' compensation claim.

HB 3243 A

Provides that violation of prohibitions against unfair claim settlement practices with respect to insurance is subject to enforcement action under Unlawful Trade Practices Act.

#### Work Session

HB 2330

Redesignates Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act as Uniform Voidable Transactions Act.
