Work Session

HB 2719 A

Directs district attorney to petition court for order requiring defendant charged with certain crimes to submit to testing for HIV and other communicable diseases.

HB 2904 A

Requires Oregon Health and Science University to annually publish on website of university certain information related to research using nonhuman primates.

HB 3148

Authorizes peace officer to request order from circuit court for information regarding missing individual.

HB 3275

Provides that supervision of certain misdemeanor offenders reverts to Department of Corrections if county opts out of providing correctional services.
