Public Hearing

SB 214

Confirms definition of "average weekly wage" as used in death benefits section to definition used generally in ORS chapter 656.

SB 228

Specifies additional circumstances under which Construction Contractors Board may revoke, suspend, condition or refuse to issue or reissue license for construction contractor, or impose civil penalty for violation of laws that regulate work of construction contractors in this state.

SB 616

Allows holder of direct shipper permit to ship up to five cases of cider or malt beverages, each containing not more than nine liters, per month to Oregon resident.

Extends sunset of property tax exemption for food processing machinery and equipment.

SB 535 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Creates refundable income tax credit for certain child care workers.
