Establishes Task Force on Organized Retail Theft.

Possible Work Session

HB 2287

Clarifies that Appraiser Certification and Licensure Board is responsible for determining specified criteria for registration or certification of appraisal management companies.

SB 882

Allows farm direct marketer sales and consignment sales of maple syrup.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 592

Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to conduct comprehensive inspections of fixed place of employment when occupational death or three or more willful or repeated violations have occurred.

SB 853

Prohibits state from paying costs of travel to or from Oregon for employee in state service who telecommutes from principal worksite outside this state.
