Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 631

Permits employees of certain state agencies to refuse to work additional mandatory overtime shift scheduled by employer when employee has already worked mandatory overtime in same month.

SB 692 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Human Services to develop or acquire and maintain information system for tracking investigations related to allegations of workplace discrimination and harassment.

SB 31

Requires Employment Department to study issues relating to family and medical leave insurance benefits.

SB 912

Authorizes Director of Employment Department to deduct amount from future weekly family and medical leave insurance benefits for overpayments due to individual's fault.

SB 913

Makes technical changes to paid family and medical leave insurance program.

SB 943 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Broadband Service Infrastructure Program within Oregon Broadband Office for purpose of offsetting cost of planning and developing high speed broadband service infrastructure in unserved and underserved areas.
